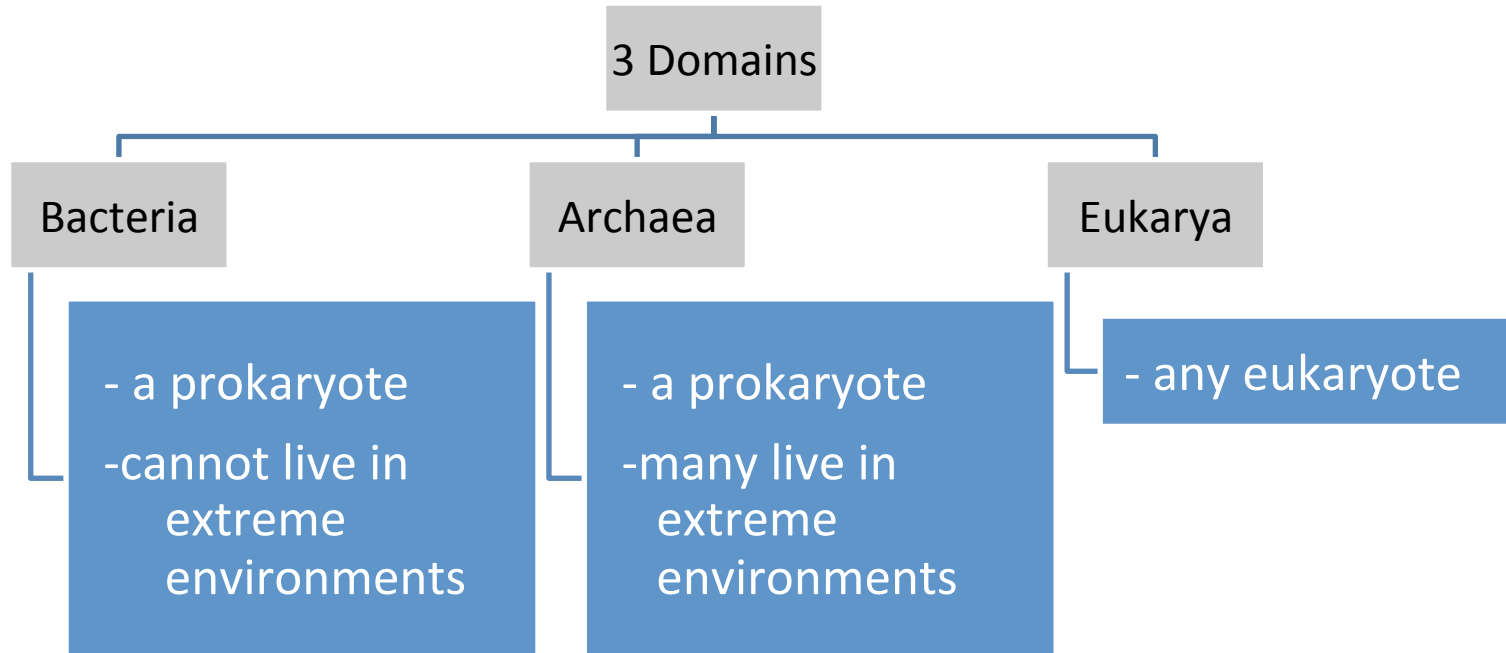

Domains



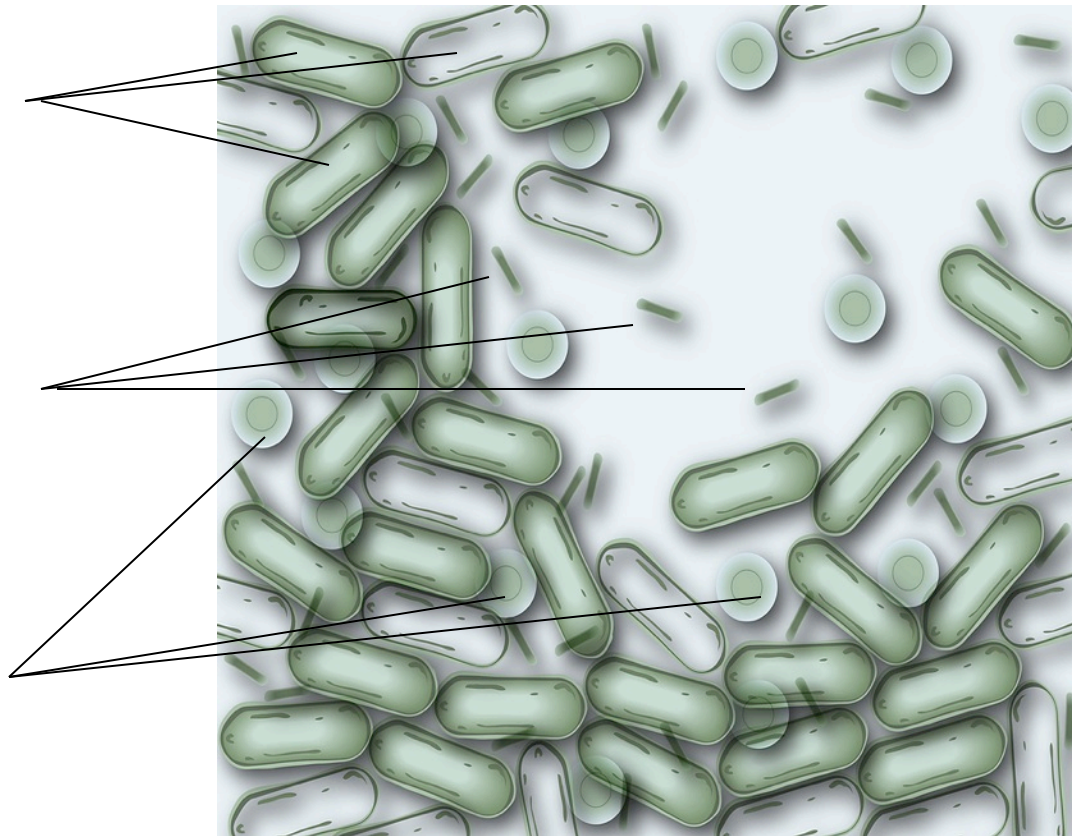
All forms of life are classified into three domains, or groups, based on their characteristics

Autotrophic



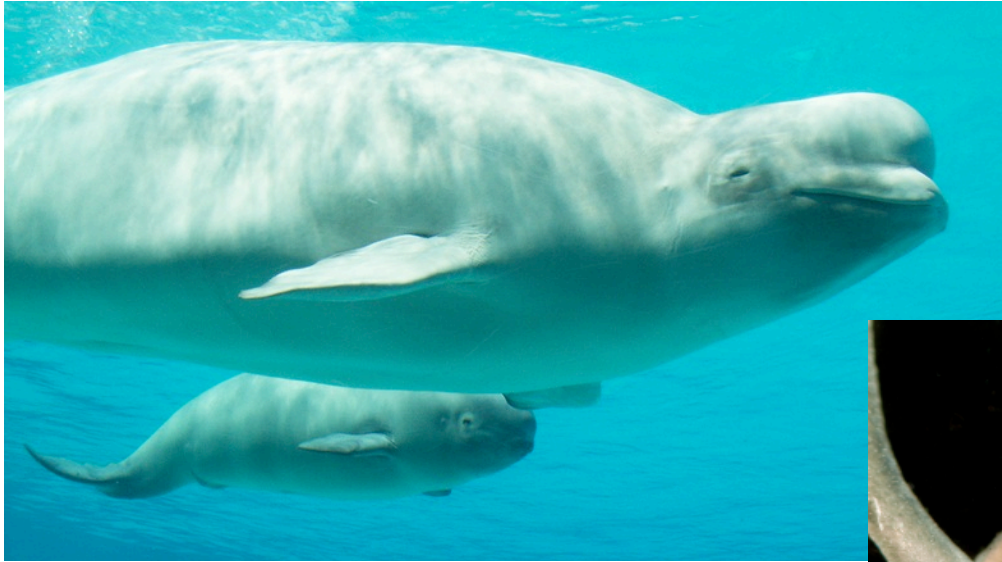
An organism that is able to make its own food

Heterotrophic

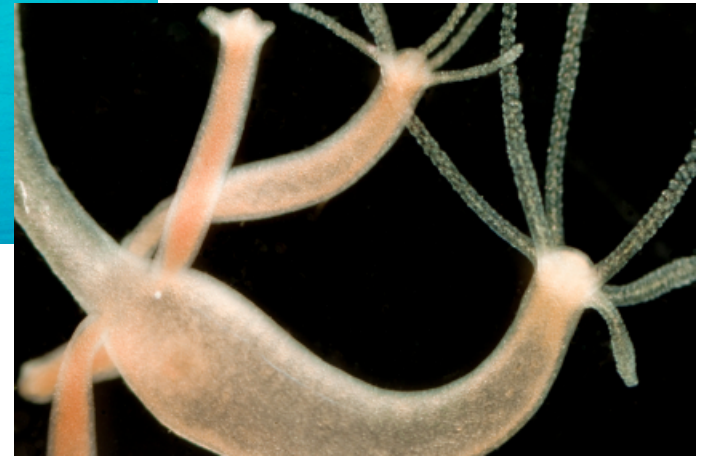


An organism that cannot make its own food.
